



MAKING LEAF MOULD

Step 1 – Use a fork to make a few small holes in a black bin liner.

Step 2 – Rake up fallen leaves.



Step 3 – Fill the black bin liner with the leaves.



Step 4 – Tie the bag securely.

Step 5 – Store the bag in a shady place for 1-2 years.

YOU WILL NEED:

Materials:

- € Fallen leaves
- € Black bin liner

Tools:

- € Rake
- € Fork

FOLLOW ON ACTIVITY:

Use the leaf mould to mulch around trees and shrubs (see Growing Support “Mulching” activity sheet). Leaf mould is also excellent to use as a soil improver- dig it in to your flower beds and vegetable areas.
