



## MAKING LEAF MOULD

**Step 1** – Use a fork to make a few small holes in a black bin liner.

**Step 2** – Rake up fallen leaves.



**Step 3** – Fill the black bin liner with the leaves.



**Step 4** – Tie the bag securely.

**Step 5** – Store the bag in a shady place for 1-2 years.

### YOU WILL NEED:

#### Materials:

- € Fallen leaves
- € Black bin liner

#### Tools:

- € Rake
- € Fork

### FOLLOW ON ACTIVITY:

Use the leaf mould to mulch around trees and shrubs (see Growing Support “Mulching” activity sheet). Leaf mould is also excellent to use as a soil improver- dig it in to your flower beds and vegetable areas.
